RE: Amendment to PCRB Filing C-365 - April 1, 2015 Loss Cost Filing

Dear Commissioner Miller:

The filing in caption presented workers compensation loss costs, rating values and rules proposed to be **effective 12:01 a.m., April 1, 2015** with respect to new and renewal policies having normal anniversary rating dates on or after that date.

During the Insurance Department's review of this filing and in the course of developing its response to comments submitted with respect to the filing by the Office of the Small Business Advocate, the PCRB discovered an error in the proposed loss cost and associated rating values for one classification, Code 956, Law firm. Because of the substantial size of Code 956, correction of that error impacted the rate test used to balance proposed loss costs to the intended overall change, and resulted in nominal changes in proposed loss costs for 37 other classifications.

This amendment to PCRB Filing C-365 corrects the original error for classification 956 and its effects on other classifications through the rate test procedure. The PCRB respectfully submits this amendment and its attachments to replace the following parts of our original filing C-365:
