RE: PCRB Filing C-367, F-Classification and USL&HW Rating Value Filing

Dear Commissioner Miller:

On behalf of the members of the Pennsylvania Compensation Rating Bureau (PCRB), I am filing workers compensation rating values for employment classifications subject to the United States Longshore and Harbor Workers (USL&HW) Compensation Act, known as F-Classifications. This filing proposes a reduction of 41.6% in collectible premium, to be **effective 12:01 a.m., October 1, 2016** with respect to new and renewal policies.

The -41.6% change in collectible rates produces a -42.1% change in manual rates. In addition, this filing proposes to revise the USL&HW Compensation Coverage Percentage, the Expense Constant and the Tax Multiplier. Full details are contained in the Actuarial Memorandum and supporting exhibits.
